3rd Grade Supply List 2020-2021

- (1) box of yellow, pre-sharpened standard **Ticonderoga** #2 pencils **(Please be sure pencils are sharpened)**
- (3) boxes of Kleenex
- (5) Large packages of baby wipes
- (1) Black Sharpie (your teacher will hold all sharpies for class usage). As an option, you may donate to the class other colors. It is school policy that all Sharpies are stored by the teacher.
- (2) pkgs. of white, ruled index cards
- (1) package of plain white copy paper (8.5" X 11" ream of paper), used for computer, printing, projects & art.
- Optional- 1 ream white cardstock paper
- Optional-black and/or colored printer ink HP901 for classroom printer.
- Earbud headphones. These will be stored in the classroom and returned to you at the end of the year.
- 1 inch clear cover binder
- 50 sheet protectors

Items to bring for your desk and backpack: (Please label everything with your name.)

- (1) **1-inch wide** 3-ring binder (Each student will be given a school agenda.)
- (1) 5-tab binder divider. Please label the sections: L.A., Science, Social Science, Math, and Language Arts
- (3) **Very Durable** Pocket folders w/holes to go inside a binder. (One will be for absent work, AR folder, and another for desk work).
- (1) Small Supply/pencil box. A Durable Zipper Bag works well too, for supplies at desk.
- (1) Small manual pencil sharpener for desk usage
- (1) **Small** box Crayola crayons (24 count)
- (1) Set of Crayola markers (8-10 count).
- (1) Small box of Colored Pencils (Please sharpen in advance)
- (4) Elmer's glue sticks
- (1) Elmer's glue bottle (10 oz.)
- (1) 12" wooden ruler with centimeter and inch measurements.
- (2) Non-clicking red pens
- (1) Personal size white board, dry erase markers and small eraser (Lakeshore style fits best in desks)
- (1) Scissors to fit child's hand
- (1) Bible (on sale in VMS office)
- (2-3) Large erasers
