

What does a typical day look like for a VMS student under the Covid-19 Re-Opening School Guidelines?

Student arrives to VMS, the parent verifies the student is Covid-19 symptom free before their child gets out of the car.

- **First day of school** all parents will need to sign in their child at their assigned station, sign a Covid-19 waiver, and verify that their child is symptom free. All adults exiting vehicles must wear masks.
- **Tuesday-Friday of the first week of school**, parents will drop off their children (with the exception of kindergarten) in the designated drop off lanes and students will proceed to their health check in station. **Kindergarten students will be walked to their classrooms daily. Parents must wear a mask.**
- **Starting the week of September 28th**, parents will use our Magnus Health App to do a daily health screen at home, we will receive a report of the results of the health screen, if the child is symptom free parents will drop off their child in the drop off lanes and their child will proceed to their classroom.

Parent verifies the student is getting out of their car with their mask on (grades 3 and up).

Student will get out of their parent's car and proceed through the drop off lanes, and go directly to the classroom (7:45-8:10).

Students will wash their hands in their classroom if there is a sink and right outside their classroom at their assigned sink if their classroom does not have a sink.

Class starts at 8:15 sharp.

Early Morning learning time.

Students will wash their hands before they go to recess.

There will be a morning recess time where students can take mask breaks, eat a snack, and play with their friends. Students will be asked to maintain some distance with friends and to not touch each other when they play.

Each class will be assigned a class basket of recess and lunch supplies for only their class to play with. This equipment will be sanitized each day.

Students will wash their hands when they enter their classroom after recess.

Mid-Morning learning time.

Wash hands to go to lunch.

Students will have another outside mask break, eat lunch, and play with friends.

Students will wash their hands as they enter class after lunch.

Afternoon learning time.

Dismissal: Grades will be assigned a pick up location on campus from 2:15-2:30. Students who are signed up for extended care will go to their extended care cohort.
